# **Data privacy policy**

The following data is saved when visiting our website:

- Browser type and version
- Date and time of the visit
- IP address
- Page visited
- Volume of data transmitted

We are unable to associate this data with a specific person.

All of this information is used by us solely for statistical purposes. It is not passed on to any third parties. We do not attempt to associate this data with any other.

The data is automatically deleted after 7 days.

#### **Cookies**

Some of the web pages use what are known as cookies. Cookies do not damage your computer and do not contain viruses. Cookies help to make our website more user-friendly, more effective and safer. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer by your browser.

Most of the cookies we use are what are known as session cookies. They are automatically deleted at the end of your visit. Other cookies remain stored on your terminal until you delete them. These cookies enable us to recognise your browser during your next visit.

You can set your browser so that you are informed when cookies are set and only allow cookies in individual cases, accept cookies in certain cases or generally exclude them and enable the automatic deletion of cookies when closing the browser. If cookies are disabled, the functionality of this website may be restricted.

Cookies that are necessary for the electronic communication process or for the provision of certain functions that you desire are stored on the basis of Art. 6 (1) (f) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). # Data transmission upon contract conclusion for services and digital content

## **Personal Data**

To the extent that Francotyp-Postalia Sverige AB collects, processes or uses personal data of users within its limited liability, this is done within the scope of the applicable legal requirements. At the current time, these are determined by the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG), the Telemedia Act (TMG) and the Telecommunications Act (TKG). According to paragraph 4g of the BDSG, the data protection officer must, upon request, make the information specified in paragraph 4e available in an appropriate manner.

We meet this obligation as follows:

a) Purpose of the data collection, processing or use

The main purpose for the collection, processing or use of personal data is to build a trustworthy and legally binding electronic communication system for digital transaction management.

The secondary purpose for the collection, processing or use of personal data is for sales and marketing (incl. advertising), the administration and support of prospective and actual customers' orders and for personnel, supplier and customer management.

The legal basis for data processing is Article 6 (1).

# b) Description of the applicable groups

In order to fulfil the above-mentioned purposes, personal data is collected, processed and used according to the following groups of persons: customer data (user) (address data including certificates, contract data, transaction data), data from communication partners (address data, transaction data)

c) Categories of recipients to whom the data may be communicated:

The user's communication partners, public bodies that have a legal right to demand the data. Internal departments that are involved in the relevant business processes (human resources, accounting, marketing, sales, telecommunications and IT). External bodies involved in carrying out the business processes. External contractors according to art. 28 EU-GDPR. Credit institutions as far as necessary for processing payments. Insurance and credit protection agencies within the framework of credit security. Third parties who receive signed documents as part of the signing rights granted to us. No personal data will otherwise be passed on to third parties without express consent. You are entitled at any time to revoke your consent and to prohibit any further use of your data.

d) Transfers of personal data to a third country or to an international organisation

The transfer of data to countries outside the EU is not planned and has never taken place to date.

e) Envisaged time limits for deletion of the different categories of data

The data will be deleted after the end of the purpose limitation or in accordance with the legal basis (usually after 10 years).

#### **Contact form**

If you send us queries via the contact form, your details from the query form including the contact data you provided there will be stored by us for the purpose of processing the query and in case of follow-up questions. These data will not be passed on without your consent.

The processing of the data entered in the contact form is therefore carried out exclusively on the basis of your consent (paragraph 6 (1) (a) GDPR). You can revoke this consent at any time. For this purpose, an informal e-mail to us is sufficient. The legality of the data processing operations carried out until the revocation remains unaffected by the revocation.

The data you entered in the contact form will remain in our possession until you request deletion, revoke your consent to storage or the purpose for data storage no longer applies (e.g. after your query has been processed). Mandatory statutory provisions – in particular, retention periods – remain unaffected.

#### Duty to provide information / Rights of data subjects

We hereby inform you about the exercising of your rights as a data subject.

## a) Right to information

You have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether personal data concerning you are being processed.

## b) Right to rectification

You have the right to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you without undue delay.

c) Right to erasure

You have the right to obtain the erasure of personal data concerning you without undue delay.

d) Right to restriction of processing

You have the right to obtain restriction of processing.

e) Notification obligation

Francotyp-Postalia Sverige AB will communicate any rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing to all recipients to which the personal data have been disclosed, unless this proves impossible or involves disproportionate effort. Francotyp-Postalia Sverige AB will inform you about those recipients if you request it.

f) Right to data portability

You have the right to receive the personal data concerning you from Francotyp-Postalia Sverige AB in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. Furthermore, you have the right to transmit those data to another controller.

g) Right to object

You are entitled at any time to revoke your consent and to object to further use of your data.
